

PRESS RELEASE

Effective April 30, 2010, a 3rd District Alderperson position in the City of South Milwaukee will be vacant due to the resignation of Alderperson James Shelenske. The Common Council will appoint a resident of the 3rd District to serve for the remainder of the term (approximately ten months), until the position is up for election in April 2011.

Any South Milwaukee U.S. citizen, residing within the 3rd District boundaries, at least 18 years of age, interested in being interviewed and considered for this appointment, should submit a letter of interest, proof of citizenship, and a city employment application to:

All applications must be received by the City Administrator by 12 Noon on Wednesday, May 12, 2010. No applications will be accepted after the deadline.

All materials submitted will become public record and candidates will be subject to a police background check.

At a special meeting scheduled for the evening of Monday, May 17, 2010, the Common Council plans to interview all qualified applicants. Each candidate will be notified of his/her scheduled interview time. The Council plans to make the appointment at the conclusion of the special meeting.
