4th District Town Hall Meeting Planned

As your aldermen, we are committed to keeping our 4th District residents informed on key issues ... and to giving you an opportunity to voice your opinions. With that in mind, we invite you to join us for a town hall meeting at **10 a.m. on Saturday, June 12, at City Hall, 2424 15th Avenue**. We'll be discussing a number of topics at this meeting and taking questions.

15th Avenue Construction Underway

You've probably noticed the orange barrels – the 15th Avenue reconstruction project is underway. As you may recall, the \$1 million project, funded primarily with federal stimulus dollars, stretches from College to Rawson Avenues. It includes the following:

- The addition of six-foot medians at Cherry, Walnut and Beech Streets to emphasize school zone and pedestrian crossings, slow traffic and improve safety;
- Pavement widening on the east side of 15th from Cherry north to Beech to accommodate a drop off lane for South Milwaukee Middle School students;
- Full replacement of the island at 15th and College Avenue; and
- Replacement of the east side connecting streets (Pine, Chestnut and Cedar).

Information Meeting Planned for Pennsylvania/Nicholson Project

A public information meeting on the Pennsylvania/Nicholson Avenue reconstruction project is planned for 5-7 p.m. on Wednesday, May 26, at City Hall. Come and review some of the design options for the upcoming project. The timeline for the \$4.5 million project – funded 80 percent by the Department of Transportation and 10 percent each by South Milwaukee and Oak Creek – calls for right-of-way acquisition and utility relocation in 2011 and construction in 2012. College Avenue Roadwork Revised

Reconstruction of College Avenue from Pennsylvania Avenue to Packard/Chicago Avenues has been approved by the DOT. They will undertake this project, along with the already planned reconstruction of College from Pennsylvania to Howell Avenue, for 2011. Stay tuned for details.

But this event is about more than bikes. It's going to be a true community festival, with a special Downtown Market planned as well as events for families and children. Stay tuned!
