On Sunday, August 15, 2010 at about 5:41pm, a City of South Milwaukee Police Officer in a marked police vehicle attempted to stop a vehicle that was observed being driven at a high rate of speed, 60-70mph in a 30mph zone, northbound on St. Hwy 32 (S. Chicago Avenue) at about Drexel Blvd. The vehicle did not stop and continued north on Hwy 32 at speeds in excess of speed limits. The South Milwaukee Officer followed the vehicle until he was able to get a license plate number and then discontinued the pursuit as the vehicle crossed College Avenue into the City of Cudahy. The vehicle was later pursued back into South Milwaukee by Cudahy Police officers going south on Hwy 32. The vehicle left South Milwaukee going north on Nicholson Avenue at College Avenue, still being pursued by Cudahy officers, and eventually crashing on Pennsylvania Avenue at Ramsey Avenue. The Cudahy Police officers took a 29 year old Greenfield man into custody and will be investigating the crash.
