Ye Old Christmas Feaste is Steeped in Grandeur and Tradition

South Milwaukee, WI – The South Milwaukee Music Parents Association (SMPA) announced final details today for the 2011 “Ye Olde Christmas Feaste”.

“Ye Olde Christmas Feaste” is a collaborative effort between the SMPA and the Fine Arts Departments at the South Milwaukee High School. Each year approximately 100 students are given the unique opportunity to perform in various brass, woodwind, string and vocal ensembles for hundreds of patrons. The student cast members are all dressed in historical costumes as they perform music of the period and serve guests in a replica of a 16th Century English castle.

Patrons are magically transported to 16th Century England for a grand evening of music and merriment. Guests enjoy a six-course dinner with table side entertainment and music of the season performed by traditionally costumed serving wenches, minstrels, madrigal singers and court jesters.

The Feaste has been a South Milwaukee High School tradition for several decades. There are students participating whose parents participated when they were attending South Milwaukee High School.
