RE: 17th AVENUE/PARKWAY DRIVE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION

On Monday, May 21, the paving contractor, Black Diamond Group, Inc., is scheduled to pave binder (base) asphalt from south of Maple Street to the Pine Street intersection. Following that work, some manholes will be adjusted by cutting through the base pavement. This is a typical construction practice to provide a better pavement ride when complete. Surface pavement will not be installed until the remaining portions of the project are finished from Pine to Hemlock.

Pavement removal and grading will continue north the week of May 21, and additional segments may be paved; but we anticipate gravel surface from Pine to Hemlock through the Memorial Day weekend.

Sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and watermain repairs/upgrades on the northerly portion of the job has taken longer than anticipated, but we expect the entire project to be substantially complete by mid-June.

Your patience with construction operations is appreciated. Please use alternate routes to 17th Avenue/Parkway Drive as much as possible during pavement removal and paving operations.
