## **MAWIB is Now Accepting Applications for EARN & LEARN Milwaukee's Summer Youth Jobs Program**

April 21, 2014 – Milwaukee -- The Milwaukee Area Workforce Investment Board (MAWIB) is now accepting applications for the Earn & Learn Summer Youth Jobs program. Young people throughout Milwaukee County interested in a summer job are encouraged to apply, 14- to 21-year-olds are eligible, but due to limited funding, priority will be given to 16- to 21-year-olds. The goal of the program is to help young people enter the world of work, build their resume and be introduced to a potential career.

- Earn & Learn Application Packet
- Proof of Date of Birth (copy)
- Social Security Card (copy of front and back)
- Proof of Income (i.e. pay stub, SSI, TANF, Food Stamps, most recent tax return, etc.)
- Proof of Address (i.e. State ID, mail, report card, etc.)
