Dear South Milwaukee Resident,

As you may know, the School District has award winning prairies surrounding the 6-12 campus. In an effort to keep the prairies healthy the District will be conducting a prescribed burn of the prairies. The burn will be performed by Applied Ecological Services Inc. and will be completed in two days between March 28<sup>th</sup> – and April 1<sup>st</sup>.

Attached you will find a flyer with details that describe why a prescribed burn is needed, and some of the safety measures that will be taken. A big variable that will determine if this prescribed burn is successful is the weather. The weather conditions need to be right for the burn to take place; this is why we have a few potential dates even though the burn will take two days. If the weather conditions are not right, the burn will not take place.
